Prof Florien Jenner graduated from Ludwig-Maximilian University, School of Veterinary Medicine, Munich, Germany, following which she completed a research fellowship at the Orthopedic Research Laboratory of Tufts University, School of Veterinary Medicine, Massachusetts, USA. She subsequently was an Intern and a Resident in Large Animal Surgery at New Bolton Center at the University of Pennsylvania School of Veterinary Medicine, which has one of the largest equine surgical facilities in the world. She then joined the University of Minnesota Veterinary Medical Center as clinical assistant professor in the large-animal surgery division, before joining the faculty at the University College Dublin. She became a diplomate of the American College of Veterinary Surgeons in 2005. Prof. Jenner completed her doctoral thesis at the Ludwig-Maximilian University investing a novel surgical treatment for navicular syndrome, and was awarded her PhD from Utrecht University for her work on articular cartilage development during embryogenesis.
